Wheeled Asphalt Paver for Public Works

SUMMARY:

This ordinance authorizes a contract with Cooper Equipment Company for one replacement wheeled asphalt paver for the Public Works Department for a total cost of \$279,806.66. Funding in the amount of \$279,806.66 is available from the Equipment Renewal and Replacement Fund FY 2025 Adopted Budget.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Submitted for City Council consideration and action is an offer submitted by Cooper Equipment Company to provide a 2025 Dynapac F1800W wheeled asphalt paver that will replace a Pucket 560 asphalt paver for the Public Works Department, Street Division. The asphalt paver being replaced has reached the end of its useful life.

The City issued a Request for Offer (RFO) for “Wheeled Asphalt Paver for Public Works” (RFO 6100018930) to Cooper Equipment Company, a cooperative vendor, on March 4, 2025, with a submission deadline of March 17, 2025. Cooper Equipment Company submitted an offer, meets the published specifications, and is recommended for award.

This purchase is made in accordance with the Texas Local Government purchasing cooperative (BuyBoard) approved through Ordinance 97097, dated January 30, 2003. This wheeled asphalt paver will be purchased from Cooper Equipment Company utilizing the BuyBoard Cooperative contract number 685-22. The use of the cooperative contract allows the Public Works Department's Street Division to access brand specific asphalt pavers to provide standardized equipment operations for all personnel using the vehicle and equipment.

The term of the contract will be upon award by City Council and will terminate upon delivery of all goods ordered.

ISSUE:

This contract will provide one Wheeled Asphalt Paver to be used by the Public Works Department, Street Division. The last day to order this paver without missing the manufacture's cutoff date is June 31, 2025. Order banks will be closed when the maximum number of orders is reached for the factory's allocated production plan. Lead time for the paver is 120 calendar days to be delivered in 2025. The paver has a warranty for two years/2,000 hour. This wheeled asphalt paver will have a 120-month life cycle.

An electric vehicle alternative is currently not readily available due to market availability, physical demands on the vehicle, service application, vehicle driving range, and charging infrastructure. This is road repair equipment and has no classification under the Federal Highway Administration. Equipment is exempt from Texas registration as pavers are prohibited from being driven on interstates and highways.

The Small Business Economic Development Advocacy (SBEDA) Ordinance requirements were waived due to the lack of small, minority and/or women owned businesses available to provide these items.

This contract is an exception to the Local Preference Program due to utilizing a cooperative; however, a local vendor is recommended for award.

The Veteran-Owned Small Business Preference Program does not apply to goods and supplies or non-professional services contracts, so no preference was applied to this contract.

ALTERNATIVES:

Should this contract not be approved, foreseeable repairs due to the age of the current asphalt paver are expected to cause downtime for the Public Works Department's Street Division. This paver is urgently needed for replacement; any delay would result in a higher cost and delay receipt of a new vehicle for use until 2026.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This ordinance authorizes a contract with Cooper Equipment Company for one replacement wheeled asphalt paver for the Public Works Department for a total cost of \$279,806.66. Funding in the amount of \$279,806.66 is available from the Equipment Renewal and Replacement Fund FY 2025 Adopted Budget.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

This contract was procured on the basis of cooperative purchasing and a Contracts Disclosure Form is not required.
