

Background



- Agreement with Angel Staffing is being amended with the availability of grant dollars awarded through the Federal Immunization and Vaccines for Children grant and the Public Health Crisis Cooperative Agreement for MPOX Response grant to:
 - Increase clinical capacity to improve routine vaccination coverage, COVID-19 & Flu vaccination coverage
 - Enhance MPOX response services, including screening, testing, treatment, and vaccination, provided at Metro Health's clinic

Fiscal Impact

Amendment to the agreement with Angel Staffing, Inc.

- Increases current term amount by \$2,718,750.00
- Amends term: September 1, 2022 through August 31, 2025
- Includes option to renew for two additional, one-year terms for up to \$93,750.00 per year
- Total contract value: \$3,187,500.00, inclusive of all renewals
- Funding in the amount of \$2,290,750.00 is from the CDC Immunization and Vaccines for Children, COVID-19 Vaccinations Round 3 Grant and \$428,000.00 is from the CDC Public Health Crisis Response Cooperative Agreement Grant for MPOX
