# Background




- As part of the FY2023 Budget, \$2.2 Million was authorized to provide connectivity and pedestrian safety improvements along the North Frio Corridor.
- The project was selected for funding through the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) for bike and pedestrian improvements.
- Project will provide connectivity for pedestrians and cyclists within N. Frio Corridor and Centro Plaza.

# Scope of Work

Project improvements include:

- Bike Lanes
- Wider Sidewalks
- Curbs and Driveways
- No Removal of Travel Lanes
- Mill and Overlay
- Signal Adjustments at four intersections
  - West Houston Street
  - West Martin Street
  - Ruiz Street
  - West Poplar Street

# Recommendation

Approval of the Advanced Funding Agreement between the City of San Antonio and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), accepting reimbursement in the estimated amount of \$5,409,644.00 from TxDOT for construction-related expenses and authorizing payment in the amount not to exceed \$96,886.00 to TxDOT for administrative oversight of federal funds for the North Frio Bike and Pedestrian Improvements (West Houston Street to Interstate Highway 10) project. The match for this project is \$1,352,411.00, which will be paid for by the City.
