Solicitation Overview



The San Antonio Police Department (SAPD) solicited proposals from qualified vendors for the installation and storage of ballistic glass windshields and side panel windows for specialty and patrol vehicles. On September 11, 2023, City Council approved a budget amendment of \$210,000 to outfit 30 specialty vehicles and on average 200 patrol vehicles each year.

- Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals (RFCSP)

Proposed Term

- 3 years with 2, 1-year options

Estimated Value

- \$1,274,000 annually
- \$6,370,000 total

Funding Source

- FY 2024 & FY 2025 General Funds
