Background



- SWMD collects varied scrap metals such as appliances, bar-b-que pits, and water heaters both curbside and at the four residential bulky drop-off facilities citywide
- SWMD is responsible for ensuring that metals collected are disposed of properly, via recycling
- Providers are expected to have the technology, equipment, facilities, and experience necessary to comply with safety and environmental requirements

Proposed Contract



- Three-year contract with two, one-year renewals
- Average 1,650 tons of metal recycling annually
- This revenue contract is expected to generate approximately \$150,000 per year, or \$750,000 for the life of the contract



Safety



- Code Compliance performs periodic inspections on metal recycling facilities to ensure compliance with all safety standards
- The recommended vendors are in good standing with the City with no pending code violations or compliance issues
- Vendors were last inspected in September & October 2024 with no violations found
- Any issues identified through inspections in the past have been addressed and resolved
