Discussion and possible action on SEP-HCP application for Grey Forest Development, LLC (LAND-SEP-APP24-46900005), located near the intersection of Kyle Seale Parkway and Heuermann Road, on the west side of TX-10 and north side of TX-1604, San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas. Staff recommends approval. Lauren Chavez, Principal Planner, stated this project is located within northwestern Bexar County and consist of approximately 2.234 acres located at the intersection of Kyle Seale Parkway and Babcock Road. The applicant is considering the future development of the project area and wishes to enroll in the SEP-HCP to mitigate impacts to the SEP-HCP Covered Species from the development activities. The Kyle Seale Parkway extension project includes 2.234 acres of golden-

cheeked warbler (GCW) habitat with the Project Area and 9.6 acres of GCW habitat within 300 feet of the project area. The project area will require a total of 9.5 GCW conservation credits. The project area does not have any black-capped vireo (BCV) habitat and will not require any BCV conservation credits. Approximately 1.09 acres is within Karst Zone 1 and approximately 1.144 acres is within Karst Zone 3. The Project Area is not located within any Critical Habitat Units nor is it within 750-ft of any occupied features. Staff recommends approval.

Lauren Chavez, Principal Planner, stated this project is located within northwestern Bexar County and consists of approximately 20.679 acres located off of W IH-10 and La Cantera Parkway. The applicant is considering the future development of the project area and wishes to enroll in the SEP-HCP to mitigate impacts to the SEP-HCP Covered Species from the development activities. The project area includes 20.65 acres of golden-cheeked warbler (GCW) habitat with the project area and 34.5 acres of GCW habitat within 300 feet of the project area. The project area will require a total of 59.0 GCW conservation credits and does not have any black-capped vireo (BCV) habitat and will not require any BCV conservation credits. The project area is located over Karst Zone 1 and totals 20.679 acres and is not located within any Critical Habitat Units nor is it within 750-ft of any occupied features. Staff recommends approval.
