SUBJECT:

Sports License Agreement with Jr. Dragons Youth Football

SUMMARY:

This ordinance authorizes the Parks and Recreation Department to execute a Sports License Agreement with Jr. Dragons Youth Football for operations, maintenance, and programming of the designated sports field at Miller's Pond Park in Council District 4.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Jr. Dragons Youth Football has established a community presence over the last 45 years. The league utilizes the designated sports field at Miller's Pond Park to provide organized youth sports activities year-round. The league has served over 110 area youth in the current operating year.

The current agreement expires December 31, 2023, and a new Sports License Agreement is proposed to commence on January 1, 2024, expiring on December 31, 2028. In lieu of rent, the league shall be responsible for operations and maintenance of the designated sports fields at Miller's Pond Park. In addition, the league will be permitted to operate concessions with proceeds benefitting their program and to offset the cost of operations and maintenance.

ISSUE:

This Ordinance authorizes the Parks and Recreation Department to execute a Sports License Agreement with Jr. Dragons Youth Football for operations, maintenance, and programming of the designated sports field at Miller's Pond Park in Council District 4. To offset operating expenses, the league retains all revenues associated with its operations including field rentals, concessions, and league registration fees. This action is consistent with the adopted SA Parks System Plan by leveraging community partnerships to expand recreational opportunities in the community.

ALTERNATIVES:

City Council could elect not to approve this action and require the fields be added to the reservation system upon expiration of the current term or leave it open for community use. Both alternatives would require the Department to maintain the field and assume all related costs.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action. This action results in cost avoidance to the City with the league maintaining the licensed premises.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval to execute a Sports License Agreement with Jr. Dragons Youth Football for operations, maintenance, and programming of the designated sports field at Miller's Pond Park in Council District 4.
