ORDINANCE

APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH FAAC INCORPORATED FOR THE PURCHASE AND DELIVERY OF A FIRE PUMP SIMULATOR FOR THE SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT, OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR A COST OF \$109,685.08. FUNDING IS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FY 2022 URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE GRANT.

WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio with a fire pump operations training simulator for the San Antonio Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the low bid was submitted by FAAC Incorporated, for a total cost of \$109,685.08;
NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bid submitted by FAAC Incorporated, for a total cost of \$109,685.08 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. Attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I** is a copy of the bid tabulation sheet.

SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$109,685.08 is available from the Department of Homeland Security FY 2022 Urban Area Security Initiative grant.

SECTION 3. Payment is authorized to FAAC Incorporated and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
