ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING FUNDS FROM THE SOUTHWEST TEXAS REGIONAL ADVISORY COUNCIL FOR TRAUMA IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$587,802.00 FOR THE SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT MOBILE INTEGRATED HEALTHCARE UNIT FOR THE HAVEN FOR HOPE ACUTE CARE STATION AND THE PROGRAM FOR INTENSIVE CARE COORDINATION FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2024 TO DECEMBER 31, 2024.

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WHEREAS, the Southwest Texas Regional Advisory Council for Trauma (STRAC) was established to facilitate the development, implementation, and operation of a regional comprehensive trauma and emergency healthcare system; and

WHEREAS, STRAC has funds in an amount up to \$587,802.00 for the San Antonio Fire Department (SAFD), Emergency Medical Services Division, Mobile Integrated Healthcare (MIH) Unit; and

WHEREAS, the funds will be used for services provided by the SAFD, MIH unit to interact with high-utilizer patients in non-emergency and emergency settings to provide proactive care, intervention and healthcare navigation in order to improve health, and maximize efficiencies;

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Chief of SAFD or designee, are hereby authorized to accept funds an amount up to \$587,802.00 from the STRAC that will be used by the SAFD MIH Unit for the Haven for Hope Acute Care Stations and the Program for Intensive Care Coordination. They are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said acceptance.

SECTION 2. Funds received in the amount of \$319,774.00 for this ordinance for Mobile Integrated Healthcare (MIH) unit will be deposited in Fund 2980001, Internal Order 820000001051 and General Ledger 4404178.

SECTION 3. Funds received in the amount of \$268,028.00 for this ordinance for Mobile Integrated Healthcare (MIH) unit will be deposited in Fund 2982000, Internal Order 820000000024 and General Ledger 4404178.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City

Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage, provided that it is passed by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, this ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
