Background



- Project Worth is a positive youth development program that promotes the social and emotional health and wellbeing of children and teens.
- Community focus groups organized by Project Worth identified lack of access to mental health care and supportive resources for teen parents as a root cause for a stagnant repeat teen birth rate.
- In 2020, Metro Health issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) to provide no cost mental health services to teens served by Project Worth.
 - University Health was the selected respondent.

Background



- **University Health agreement original terms:**
 - Initial 6-month term with options to renew for 2.5 years for total amount up to \$525,000.00.
 - Final term end date of March 31, 2024
- **Contract Amendment:**
 - Extends final renewal term to end September 30, 2024.
 - Increases total number of counseling sessions from 500 to 1,000.
 - Adds \$55,000.00

Fiscal Impact



Amendment to the agreement with University Health:

- Increase current term amount by \$55,000.00, from \$37,500.00 to \$92,500.00.
- Total contract value: \$580,000.00
 - Inclusive of all renewals
- Amended term: October 1, 2023 – September 20, 2024
- Funded by Medicaid 1115 Waiver
- No Impact to General Fund
