ORDINANCE

**A STREET NAME CHANGE REQUEST TO RENAME “NATIONWIDE DRIVE” TO
“WESTOVER PLACE” LOCATED IN CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 6, IN SAN
ANTONIO, TEXAS.**

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio Development Services Department staff received a Street Name Change Application to rename “Nationwide Drive” to “Westover Place”; and

WHEREAS, staff began implementing this request through the street name change process as required by Chapter 6 of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, staff conducted a technical review, finding the change to conform to City Code requirements for a street name change; and

WHEREAS, staff forwarded the request to all City of San Antonio departments and outside agencies for review and no opposition was identified

WHEREAS, staff properly posted and mailed notice of this street name change request to abutting property owners, and notice requirements for renaming of the street have been satisfied in accordance with Chapter 6 of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, city staff reached out to all impacted parties on November 16, 2023, allowing all interested persons to be heard; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on January 24, 2024, allowing all interested persons to be heard, and recommended approval; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO;

SECTION 1. “Nationwide Drive” located in City Council District 6 between State Highway 151 and Rogers Road is hereby changed to “Westover Place”. All street name change requirements of Chapter 6 of the City Code have been met. The location of the street name change is more specifically depicted in Attachment I. City Staff is directed to provide appropriate signage to this effect.

SECTION 2. (Financials to be provided)

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager’s designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective 10 days after passage.
