Kimberly LeBlanc provided an overview of the Film Festival Funding guidelines and explained the goal of the program is to increase investment in the local film culture in San Antonio as laid out by the Film Strategic plan. Four applications were received this cycle and were reviewed by a panel comprised of Performing Arts, Film and Music Committee members. Based on these reviews and Executive review of the results, staff recommendation is to fund all four film festival at the full 20% of total festival budget amount as set forth by the program guidelines.

Hill provided an update on the increased submission rate due to program improvements and increased marketing efforts. To date, a total of 36 complete submissions have been received to the first two rounds of the program. The first round awarded eight honorariums and the second round panel review is wrapping up with another eight songs expected to be awarded the honorarium. The third and final round of FY 24 will be open or submission from Tuesday, June 18 – Tuesday, August 6.

Make Music Day

To date, there will be 12 unique locations hosting events for this year's event including an all-day (10am-10pm) activation hosted in partnership by the Department of Arts & Culture and Texas Public Radio, Musical Bridges Around the World's Youth Summer Showcase at the Instituto Cultural de Mexico, Alamo City Arts presenting Mariachi Gallos de Oro performing with the Fiesta Noche del Rio dancers and a performance by the Memory Lane Dance Band at San Antonio Botanical Gardens, DJ Mr. G. at Luminaria's pop-up gallery in St. Paul Square, The AM Project at Hemisfair, the Classical Music Institute's 210 Festival Student Concert at the Edgewood Theatre of Performing Arts, OPERA San Antonio with the Classical Music Institute) hosting "Explore Opera for

Kids” at San Antonio Public Library’s Parman Branch, and the Children's Chorus of San Antonio performing “Sounds of Summer” at the Tobin Center. All Make Music Day events are free and open to the public.

CineFestival

LeBlanc provided an overview and invitation to the 45th annual CineFestival happening at the Carver Community Cultural Center and Alamo Drafthouse due to the renovations happening at the Guadalupe Cultural Arts Center. CineFestival will take place July 11-14, 2024. As an addition to the festival’s programming, the San Antonio Film Commission will host a Coffee Talk on July 12, from 11am – 1pm in the Carver’s Jo Long Theater lobby. This event will be free and open to the public.
