Overview



- Amend Chapter 22 entitled “Parks and Recreation” to modify alcohol exemptions locations at First Tee-Greater San Antonio, Mac Wylie Golf Center, allowable vending at Woodlawn Lake Park, and other minor code updates.
- Chapter 22 governs Parks and Recreation.
- No major substantive or major policy changes with these updates.
- Updates were presented to the Community Health Committee on December 16, 2024.
- Presented to the Parks and Recreation Board on January 27, 2025.

Section 22-2: Vending in Parks



- CD 7 Requested Parks Evaluate Coffee Vending Services for Woodlawn Lake Park
 - Current Code only allows for a Mobile Vending Program
 - Parks will work through a solicitation process for this service in Spring 2025
- Code Updates:
 - Adds Woodlawn Lake Community Room for Food and Non-Alcoholic Drink Vending Services
 - Streamlines language for current Mobile Vending Program



Section 22-1: Exemption from Alcohol Restriction



Removes

- Koger Stokes Softball Complex at San Pedro Springs Park

Adds

- Polo Field Driving Range Building at Brackenridge Park (First Tee-Greater SA)
- Golf Expansion Area at O.P. Schnabel Park (Mac Wylie Golf Center)

Updates

- Updates to Various Facility Name Changes
 - ex: San Antonio Little Theater is now the San Pedro Playhouse

 - Remove Section
- Section 22-28: Park Curfew Hours
 - Remove subsection (d): Comanche Lookout Park
- Section 22-33: Hertzberg Circus Museum Fees

 - Remove Sections 116, 117, and 119-131
 - Updates Section 118
