ORDINANCE

APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH RUSH TRUCK CENTERS OF TEXAS, L.P., DBA RUSH TRUCK CENTER, SAN ANTONIO, FOR THREE REPLACEMENT REAR LOAD REFUSE TRUCKS FOR THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$735,510.00. FUNDING IS FROM THE EQUIPMENT RENEWAL AND REPLACEMENT FUND FY 2024 ADOPTED BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by Rush Truck Centers of Texas, L.P., dba Rush Truck Center, San Antonio, for three replacement rear load refuse trucks for the Solid Waste Management Department for a total cost of \$735,510.00; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Local Government Code indicates that competitive bidding is not required under section 252.022(a)(2), which provides for a procurement necessary to protect the public health or safety; and

WHEREAS, funding is available from the Equipment Renewal and Replacement Fund FY 2024 Adopted Budget; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer submitted by Rush Truck Centers of Texas, L.P., dba Rush Truck Center, San Antonio, for three replacement rear load refuse trucks for the Solid Waste Management Department for a total cost of \$735,510.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the bid tabulation and contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$60,000.00 is available in Fund 72001000, Cost Center 3503200001 and General Ledger 5709080 as part of the Fiscal Year 2024 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. Payment in the amount of \$735,510.00 is authorized to Rush Truck Centers of Texas, L.P., dba Rush Truck Center, San Antonio, and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.
