Air Service Update

SUMMARY:

Air Service Administrator Jacob Tyler will brief the Airport Advisory Commission members on the new air service markets and expanded service on current markets at the San Antonio International Airport. The briefing will provide an opportunity for Commission members to ask questions and provide input.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In 2024, San Antonio International Airport broke its passenger record with 11,094,278 passengers, beating the previous record by nearly 4% set in 2023 and marking the first time in airport history it served more than 11 million passengers. During the year, the airport broke a monthly passenger record 11 out of 12 months. July officially became the busiest month ever recorded and October broke the one million passenger level for the first time.

During the year, the airport launched several new routes and saw the expansion of existing service. International expansion landed the airport's first-ever nonstop flights to Europe with Condor and several additional flights to Mexico including a new destination, Torreon. Domestically, highlights included expansion of service on Spirit Airlines, seasonal non-stops to Philadelphia on American Airlines, and daily service to Boston on Delta Air Lines.

In March 2025, American Airlines will launch its non-stop service to Reagan National Airport, while Spirit will launch the first Caribbean service to San Juan, Puerto Rico.
