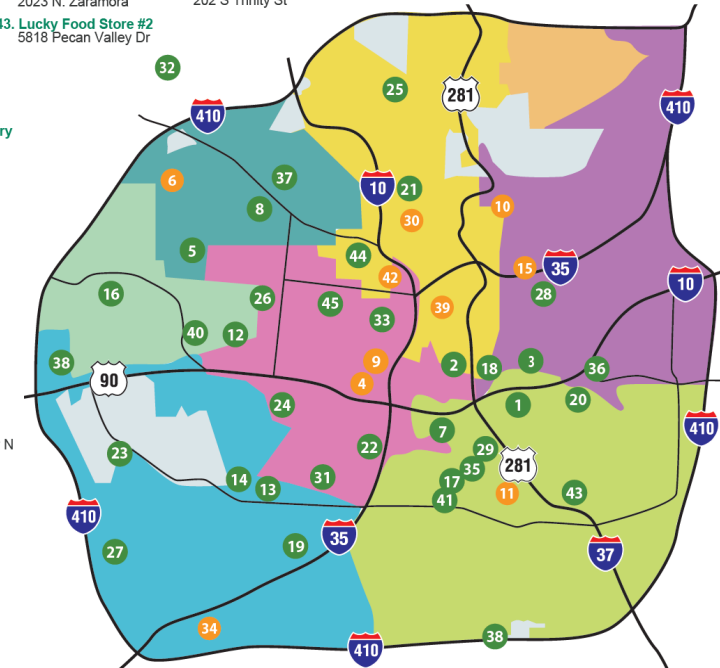

Background



- Metro Health plans to increase access to healthy foods in prioritized neighborhoods by expanding the Healthy Corner Stores program to 50 or more locations by 2026.
- Stores pending onboarding in Fiscal Year 2025 include:
 1. Mini Food Mart (District 5)
 2. Circle AZ Food Mart (District 3)
 3. Martin Food Mart (District 7)
 4. Express Foods La Norteña Fruit and Grocery (District 7)
 5. The Lemon Girls (District 1)
 6. Alibaba International Food Mart (District 8)



Background



- Metro Health's collaboration with the Sustainable Food Center (SFC) Double Up Food Bucks program began in April 2024
- Initiative supports improved access to nutritious food and affordable food options
- Provides incentives for eligible SNAP consumers to purchase fruits and vegetables
- Discounts are applied at the time of sale
- Participating stores are reimbursed by the Sustainable Food Center

Background



- SFC was awarded the USDA GusNIP grant to support the Double Up Food Bucks program
- SFC will sub-award grant funds to Metro Health
- Funding will support the expansion of the Double Up Food Bucks program in San Antonio
- Metro Health staff will recruit and onboard stores for participation in the Double Up Food Bucks program

Fiscal Impact



- Agreements with new and existing corner stores for participation in the Healthy Corner Stores program for an initial term: October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025 with two, one-year renewal options.
 - City will provide subsidized and discounted produce, as well as equipment like shelving and refrigerators to increase access to healthy foods in the community.
- Agreement with the Sustainable Food Center for an initial term: September 1, 2024 to August 31, 2025 with three, one-year renewal options.
 - Amount: up to \$62,725 annually, \$268,440 total

Recommendation



- Staff recommends City Council approval.
