Background



- Metro Health's Oral Health Program provides:
 - Diagnostic and preventive care to more than 20,000 children living below the federal poverty guidelines
 - Dental case management, assisting participating families in accessing and establishing routine dental care to include treatment for untreated tooth decay.

Background



- The Oral Health Program is currently contracted to provide dental services for approximately 6,166 children enrolled in Head Start and Early Head Start programs across Bexar County.
- Metro Health staff provide on-site oral health assessments and fluoride varnish application for participating children.
- In the 2023-2024 school year, 1,556 exams were completed for children enrolled in Family Service Association (FSA) Head Start and Early Head Start programs.
- Through these agreements with FSA, Metro Health will continue to provide services to enrollees of the FSA Head Start and Early Head Start programs.

Fiscal Impact



FSA Head Start Agreement

- Term: September 1, 2024 through August 31, 2025
 - Three, one-year renewal options
- Initial term amount: \$48,969
- Total amount: \$195,876
- In-kind Match: \$9,794 per term, funded through General Fund

FSA Early Head Start Agreement

- Term: October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2026
 - One, two-year renewal option
- In-kind amount of \$10,673 per year, funded through General Fund
- Metro Health will not seek reimbursement for Early Head Start services
