# Background



- The City of San Antonio receives grant funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to help people and communities to be more prepared by developing the capabilities needed to prevent, protect against, respond to, recover from, and mitigate against all threats and hazards.
- FEMA funding, as part of the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant allows the City to enter into an agreement with TDEM to provide Training.

# All Hazards Incident Management Training



## 5 Training Courses Include:

- All Hazards Incident Management Training
  - All Hazards Supply Unit Leader
  - All Hazards Resources Unit Leader
  - All Hazards Operations Section Chief
  - All Hazards Incident Commander
- Training will take place before the end of calendar year 2025.

# Alternatives & Recommendation



- Should this ILA not be approved the SAFD and SAOEM will not be able to deliver all hazards emergency management training, as a result personnel will not be properly trained and qualified in the National Incident Management System and Incident Command, which could be detrimental during an emergency like a terrorist attack.
- Staff recommends approval of this ordinance to authorize the acceptance of an Interlocal Agreement with TDEM for coordination and delivery of All Hazards Incident Management Training.
