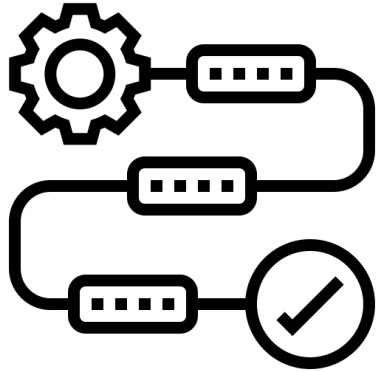

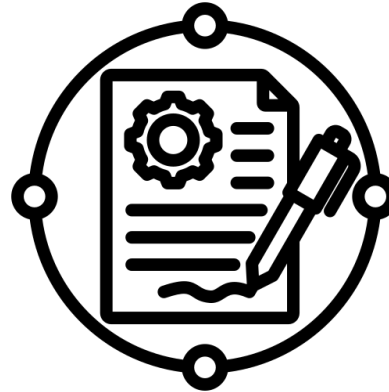

# Federal Contract Terms



## RFP Process

- June – November 2022
- Council approved on December 15, 2022



## Initial Term

- January 1, 2022 – December 31, 2024



## Renewal Terms

- Two, two-year extensions available
- 1<sup>st</sup> Renewal Term – January 1, 2025 – December 31, 2026
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Renewal Term – January 1, 2027 – December 31, 2028
