

**RFCA #23-197291**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Office of Historic Preservation or designee, is hereby authorized to accept additional funds in the amount of \$5,401.04 for a total grant award of \$35,401.04 from the Texas Historical Commission. This grant requires a match to include in-kind services or cash of the lesser of \$35,401.04 or 50% of eligible costs which has been fully met for the new total award amount of \$35,401.04.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Office of Historic Preservation or designee, is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said acceptance.

**SECTION 3.** Upon acceptance of this award, \$5,401.04 from the Texas Historical Commission will be appropriated into Fund 2200641005 and Internal Order 141000000009. A final budget, which will include SAP Internal Orders and SAP GL Accounts, will be submitted by the Office of Historic Preservation upon award.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
