ORDINANCE

**APPROVING THE WORKFORCE SOLUTIONS ALAMO 2025-2028
LOCAL PLAN, AS APPROVED BY THE COMMITTEE OF SIX ON
_____ FOR SUBMISSION TO THE TEXAS WORKFORCE
COMMISSION**

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WHEREAS, funding for and oversight of workforce development services in Texas is provided by the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) through 28 regional workforce boards, including the locally-created Workforce Solutions Alamo (WSA) which services the areas of Atascosa, Bandera, Bexar, Comal, Frio, Gillespie, Guadalupe, Karnes, Kendall, Kerr, Medina, and Wilson counties; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio, Bexar County and area county judges (collectively referred to as the “Principals”) are parties to an Interlocal Agreement with WSA through the Chief Elected Officials (CEOs), whereby they oversee the planning, budgeting, administration, and execution of WSA programs in the WSA Service Area; and

WHEREAS, the CEOs have established a “Committee of Six” to carry out some of their duties and responsibilities, which includes the creation and implementation of a four-year WSA Local Plan, as mandated by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act; and

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2025, the Committee of Six approved the 2025-2028 WSA Local Plan, and on March 14, 2025, the WSA Board of Directors approved the 2025-2028 WSA Local Plan; and

WHEREAS, final approval must be obtained from the San Antonio City Council and the surrounding county’s respective political bodies prior to submission to TWC; and

WHEREAS, WSA presented the plan to the City Council’s Economic Workforce Development Committee on March 25, 2025, which recommended it be moved forward for full council approval.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The 2025-2028 Workforce Solutions Alamo Local Plan as approved by the Committee of Six for submission to the Texas Workforce Commission, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by eight (8) votes or more and upon ten (10) days following its passage if approved by fewer than eight (8) votes.
