

**DRAFT ORDINANCE**

**APPROVING “BARBARA ‘ROBBIE’ ROBINETTE  
COMMUNITY AND SENIOR CENTER” AS THE NAME OF THE  
DISTRICT 4 HERITAGE PARK COMMUNITY AND SENIOR  
CENTER LOCATED AT 1423 SOUTH ELLISON DRIVE.**

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**WHEREAS**, on March 13, 2024, the City Clerk’s Office received a request to name the new Multi-Generational Center at 1423 South Ellison Drive, the “Barbara ‘Robbie’ Robinette Community & Senior Center,” and on March 28, 2024, a Naming Committee was established; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing date was held on May 21, 2024, and public notice was provided and garnered four responses with all in favor of the name ; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Human Services received one email in support of the proposed name, expressing their pride in Barbara Robinette’s services to the community and the country in the United States Air Force; and

**WHEREAS**, Councilmember Rocha Garcia also highlighted her community efforts and as a public servant who gave so much to her community and was a longtime resident of District 4; and was supportive of the naming of the center after Ms. Robinette; and

**WHEREAS**, the name “Barbara ‘Robbie’ Robinette Community & Senior Center” is proposed as the District 4 multigenerational center name for City Council consideration and approval; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The name “Barbara ‘Robbie’ Robinette Community & Senior Center” is approved as the name of the District 4 Senior and Community Center located at 1423 South Ellison Drive.

**SECTION 2.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager’s designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.
