Texas Election Code Requirements



- A candidate must receive more than 50% of the total votes to win (Majority Vote)
 - For a city with a population of 200,000 or more
 - For a City that has terms longer than 2 years
- If no candidate received the vote necessary to be elected in an election requiring a majority vote, a runoff election is required under Section 2.021
- The candidates in a runoff election are the candidates who receive the highest and second highest number of votes in the main election Section 2.023
