Board Appointments

SUMMARY:

Approving Robert Benke as the At-Large Appointee to the Building Standard Board for the remainder of an unexpired term ending May 31, 2025.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Building Standards Board is a citizen-based board and has 14 members appointed by City Council: two panels of seven members each. The Board is appointed by the City Council with each City Council member appointing their own representative to the board. Board composition is comprised of the following categories: Architect, Engineer, General Contractor, Social Worker, Health Care Professional, Retired individual (over the age of 64) and Veteran of the United States Military. A professional property manager may be substituted for one general contractor and/or one social worker. Members serve overlapping two-year terms and there is no limit on the number of terms that may be served.

ISSUE:

Building Standards Board appointments require full City Council approval. On May 20, 2024, the Planning and Community Development Council Committee's recommended Robert Benke for the At-Large seat.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Office of the City Clerk will continue to promote vacancies.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact.

RECOMMENDATION:

The City Clerk recommends forwarding the Planning and Community Development Council Committee's recommendations for approval by the full City Council at the next available A Session.
