ORDINANCE

RATIFYING PAYMENT TO CLEAN HARBORS ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, INC., FOR THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT FOR AN EMERGENCY RESPONSE CLEAN UP AND WASTE DISPOSAL SERVICES RELATED TO A REFUSE TRUCK SPILL FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$125,495.57. COSTS FOR SERVICES WERE INCURRED IN FY 2024 AND FUNDED THROUGH THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE FUND.

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WHEREAS, submitted for City Council ratification is the payment to Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc., for the Solid Waste Management Department for an emergency response clean up and waste disposal services related to a refuse truck spill for a total cost of \$125,495.57; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Local Government Code indicates that competitive bidding is not required under section 252.022(a)(2), which provides for a procurement necessary to protect the public health or safety; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The payment to Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc., for the Solid Waste Management Department for an emergency response clean up and waste disposal services related to a refuse truck spill for a total cost of \$125,495.57 is hereby ratified, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements.

SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$125,495.57 is available in Fund 55001000, Cost Center 5555310002 General Ledger 5201040 as part of the Fiscal Year 2025 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. Payment to Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc., in the amount of \$125,495.57 is hereby ratified.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
