ORDINANCE

**APPROVING THE REQUEST FOR CONSENT FOR THE CREATION OF
KENDALL COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 WITHIN
A PORTION OF THE CITY'S EXTRA TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION FOR
THE PROVISION OF FIRE SUPPRESSION AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL
SERVICES BY THE DISTRICT.**

WHEREAS, in 2022 certain residents of Kendall County filed a petition with the Kendall County Commissioner's Court in which they had sought to form an Emergency Services District No. 1 (ESD), which would include a portion of the Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ) of the City of San Antonio (COSA), but that petition ultimately was not successful; and

WHEREAS, certain residents of Kendall County have again filed a new petition with the Kendall County Commissioner's Court in which they seek to form an Emergency Services District No. 1 (ESD), which would include a portion of the Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ) of the City of San Antonio (COSA); and

WHEREAS, the citizens involved in the project have applied to COSA for consent to include that portion of the ETJ within the proposed special district as required by Ch. 775 of the Texas Health and Safety Code; and

WHEREAS, the affected portion of the City's ETJ is more particularly described in the Petition for Creation of the District attached as Attachment I; and

WHEREAS, City staff has reviewed the proposal and has recommended that consent be granted;
NOW THEREFORE;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Consent is granted to include the portion of the COSA ETJ within the proposed Kendall County ESD No. 1 in accordance with the terms of Chapter 775, Texas Health and Safety Code. Attachment I is attached and incorporated herein for reference.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this action to the County Judge of Kendall County on behalf of the COSA.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund

Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
