ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE GREATER:SATX 2025 OPERATIONS PLAN AND FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT ATTRACTION PLAN. FUNDING ASSOCIATED WITH THE PLANS WAS APPROVED AS PART OF THE FY2025 ADOPTED BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, since 2010, the City of San Antonio (“City”) has partnered with greater:SATX (gSATX) to assist in carrying out the City’s goals in the areas of global target industry recruitment, industry retention and expansion, and entrepreneurial and workforce development; and

WHEREAS, in 2024, City Council approved an updated Service Agreement (“the Agreement”) with gSATX to support a continued strategic framework that focuses initiatives within three pillars of Jobs, People, and Place; and

WHEREAS, an extension of the Agreement requires the development of an annual Operations Plan and Foreign Direct Investment Attraction plan approved by the respective governing bodies of both City and gSATX; and

WHEREAS, the 2025 Operations Plan and Foreign Direct Investment Attraction Plan is being submitted by City staff for approval in accordance with the requirements of the Agreement. **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The greater:SATX 2025 Operations Plan and Foreign Direct Investment Attraction Plan is hereby approved. A copy of the plans is attached to this Ordinance as **Attachment I.**

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$829,250.00 for this ordinance is available as part of the Fiscal Year 2025 Adopted Budget approved by City Council per the table below.

SECTION 3. Payment is authorized to greater:SATX and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager’s designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.
