Background



University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio (UT Health) Ricardo Salinas Pediatric Dental Clinic

- Non-profit pediatric dental clinic located on the west side of San Antonio.
- Staffed by UT Health pediatric dentistry faculty and pediatric dentistry residents.
- Provides accessible high-quality comprehensive and emergency oral health care for children ages 6 months through 17 years of age.
- Serves uninsured, underinsured, and underserved children from Bexar County mostly from City Council Districts 1, 4, 5, 6, and 7.

Background



- In August 2024, UT Health requested funding for the Clinic to offset operating costs of providing specialty dental services to those who cannot afford to receive services through other means.
- Councilwoman Castillo secured support from the City Council to provide the needed funding through the budget amendment process.
- Funding was approved during the annual adopted budget process.

Fiscal Impact



- Agreement with UT Health:
 - Term: January 1, 2025 through September 30, 2025
 - Term Amount: \$150,000.00
 - One, one-year renewal option
 - Total contract value: \$300,000.00
 - Funding is available from the General Fund FY 2025 Adopted Budget

Recommendation



- Staff recommends City Council approval.
