SUBJECT:

Bexar Appraisal District Appointment

SUMMARY:

A Resolution allocating the City's 1010 votes in favor of its nominee, Dr. Adriana Rocha Garcia.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Bexar Appraisal District Board of Directors is comprised of five members representing various taxing entities, and as a taxing unit, the City is entitled to nominate up to five candidates to serve on the Bexar Appraisal District Board of Directors. In accordance with the Property Tax Code, Section 6.03, members serve terms beginning on January 1.

The total number of votes allocated to the City of San Antonio is 1010, which is determined by a formula based on each taxing district's percentage of property tax imposed in the district for the preceding year. Mayor Nirenberg submitted a memo to the City Clerk nominating Dr. Adrianna Rocha Garcia to the Bexar Appraisal District Board of Directors and City Council adopted a resolution nominating Dr. Rocha Garcia on October 3, 2024. Dr. Rocha Garcia has served on the Board since January 1, 2022.

ISSUE:

Mayor Nirenberg received notification of the upcoming election of the Bexar Appraisal District Board of Directors requesting allocation of its 1010 votes by December 15, 2024. Upon approval, the Resolution will be sent to the Chief Appraiser for submission of the City's 1010 votes on the Official Ballot. The Chief Appraiser will count the votes and declare the five candidates with the greatest number of votes elected and submit the results to each taxing entity by December 31, 2024.

ALTERNATIVES:

City Council could apportion its votes to other nominees.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact.

RECOMMENDATION:

The City Clerk recommends approval of the required Resolution submitting the name of the City's nominee and allocating its votes in favor of its nominee.
