ORDINANCE

**A SPORTS LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH JR. DRAGONS YOUTH
FOOTBALL FOR OPERATIONS, MAINTENANCE, AND
PROGRAMMING OF THE DESIGNATED SPORTS FIELD AT
MILLER'S POND PARK. THERE IS NO FISCAL IMPACT
ASSOCIATED WITH THIS ORDINANCE.**

WHEREAS, the Jr. Dragons Youth Football has established a community presence over the last 45 years; and

WHEREAS, the league utilizes the designated sports fields at Miller's Pond Park to provide organized youth sports activities year-round and has served over 110 area youth in the current operating year; and

WHEREAS, the current agreement expires December 31, 2023, and a new Sports License Agreement is proposed to commence on January 1, 2024, and will expire on December 31, 2028; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of rent, the league shall be responsible for operations and maintenance of the designated sports fields at Miller's Pond Park and be permitted to operate concessions with proceeds benefitting their program and to offset the cost of operations and maintenance.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee or the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department or designee is authorized to approve a Sports License Agreement with Jr. Dragons Youth Football for operations, maintenance, and programming of the designated sports fields at Miller's Pond Park.

SECTION 2. There is no fiscal impact associated with this action. No fiscal ordinance language is required.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
