ORDINANCE

**AWARDING THE 2024 TASK ORDER CONTRACT FOR
PAVEMENT MARKINGS PACKAGE C IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
EXCEED \$4,567,921.00 TO M&M STRIPING AND POWER
WASHING, LLC FOR COMPLETION OF ROADWAY PAVEMENT
MARKINGS LOCATED CITYWIDE. FUNDING IS AVAILABLE
FROM THE GENERAL FUND, THE ADVANCED
TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT FUND, AND THE
NEIGHBORHOOD ACCESS AND MOBILITY PROGRAM
INCLUDED IN THE FY 2024 – FY 2029 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS
PROGRAM.**

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WHEREAS, the FY 2024 budget contains \$11,300,000.00 to maintain citywide pavement markings. This funding will provide for the completion of approximately 1229 lane miles of pavement markings for this fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, this task order contract is a capacity-based contract that will be utilized primarily to complete pavement marking maintenance of existing markings on projects identified in the FY 2024 Infrastructure Management Program, along with additional projects that materialize throughout the contract term and can be completed within the contract capacity. Work activities will be allocated in the form of task orders as the availability of funds is identified; and

WHEREAS, this project was advertised on September 8, 2023 and two (2) bids were received and opened on October 10, 2023, with M&M Striping and Power Washing, LLC submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, M&M Striping and Power Washing, LLC has committed to meeting the 21% Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) subcontracting goal set by the Small Business Economic Development Advocacy (SBEDA) Program's Goal Setting Committee; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid and awards the 2024 Task Order Contract for Pavement Markings Package C in an amount not to exceed \$4,567,921.00 to M&M Striping and Power Washing, LLC for completion of roadway pavement markings located citywide. Funding is available from the General Fund, the Advanced Transportation District Fund, and the Neighborhood Access and Mobility Program included in the FY 2024 – FY 2029 Capital Improvements Program; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Public Works Department or designee, is authorized to accept the lowest responsive bid and awards the FY 2024 Task Order Contract for Pavement Markings Package C in an amount not to exceed \$4,567,921.00 to M&M Striping and Power Washing, LLC.

SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance will be identified when work orders are issued. If funding for any work orders is not previously appropriated, funding will be identified and appropriated through subsequent City Council action. Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating, Grants, and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with Operating, Grants, and/or Capital Budgets for current and future fiscal years.

SECTION 3. Payment not to exceed \$4,567,921.00 is authorized to be encumbered with purchase orders and made payable to M&M Striping and Power Washing, LLC., for 2024 Pavement Markings Package C Task Order Contract. Payment is in support of Project 23-04122 F2024 Pavement Markings using WBS 23-04122-05-02-01 with GL 5201140. Funding is provided by General Fund and is in the FY24-FY29 CIP Budget.

Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with approved operating and/or capital budgets for current and future fiscal years.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Fund Numbers, Project Definitions, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, Fund Centers, Cost Centers, Functional Areas, Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
