





# FY 2023 Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Law Enforcement Mental Health and Wellness Act (LEMHWA) Grant



- U.S. Department of Justice FY23 Law Enforcement Mental Health and Wellness Act grant
- Grant solicitation on February 21, 2023
- Application authorized through a Grant Application Approval Form March 28, 2023
- Award notification received October 13, 2023
- Applied for \$175,000.00, received \$69,726.00

# Background

- Program will focus on services surrounding officer emotional and mental health well being
- The grant will fund enhancements of the newly created Wellness Unit



# Background

## Funding will be used for:

- Financial consulting designed with officers in mind
- Financial wellness training, customized financial planning, and life insurance
- Outside agency counseling services for officers
