ORDINANCE

**APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH DÉCORIQ LLC FOR 240 CASES OF
LIGHT-EMITTING DIODE (LED) MULTICOLOR HOLIDAY LIGHTS
FOR THE CITY CENTER DEVELOPMENT & OPERATIONS
DEPARTMENT FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$53,652. FUNDING IS FROM
THE GENERAL FUND FY 2024 ADOPTED BUDGET.**

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WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by DécorIQ LLC through the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative (a.k.a. the “Buyboard”), for 240 cases of light-emitting diode (LED) multicolor holiday lights for the City Center Development & Operations Department for downtown parks and plazas for a total cost of \$53,652.00, utilizing the BuyBoard Cooperative Contract No. 735-24; and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Ordinance No. 97097 on January 30, 2003; and

WHEREAS, funds are available from the General Fund FY 2024 Adopted budget; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer submitted by DécorIQ for 240 cases of LED multicolor holiday lights for the City Center Development & Operations Department for downtown parks and plazas for a total cost of \$53,652.00, utilizing the BuyBoard Cooperative Contract No. 735-24 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the bid tabulation sheet and contract are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$53,652.00 is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 1902010001 and General Ledger 5204050 as part of the Fiscal Year 2024 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. Payment in the amount of \$53,652.00 is authorized to DécorIQ LLC and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, or the City Manager’s designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP

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Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
