ORDINANCE

**REAPPOINTING ALEJANDRA LOPEZ (CITY OF SAN ANTONIO),
PATRICIA MUZQUIZ CANTOR (CITY OF SAN ANTONIO), DAN
CURRY (BEXAR COUNTY) AND THOMAS GUEVARA (BEXAR
COUNTY) TO THE SABC SOCCER PFC BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR
THE REMAINDER OF UNEXPIRED TERMS OF OFFICE TO EXPIRE
MAY 31, 2025.**

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2015-12-17-0068R, passed and approved December 17, 2015, the City Council authorized and approved the creation of SABC SOCCER PFC ("Corporation"); authorized and approved the Articles of Incorporation ("Articles") and the Bylaws ("Bylaws") of the Corporation; and authorized and approved other matters in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, the Articles provide that the City Council is the Governing Body of the Corporation; and

WHEREAS, Article Eight (a) of the Articles provides that the affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a minimum four (4) member Board (the "Board"), which shall be composed of representatives appointed by the Governing Body; and

WHEREAS, Article Eight (b) of the Articles provides that at least one half of the Board's members shall be recommended by Bexar County, Texas by and through its Commissioners Court; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends the reappointment of Alejandra Lopez and Patricia Muzquiz Cantor to the Board and Bexar County recommends the reappointment of Thomas Guevara and Dan Curry to the Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the appointments of Directors of the Corporation as described above are necessary and appropriate and should be made; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Alejandra Lopez, Patricia Muzquiz Cantor, Thomas Guevara and Dan Curry are each appointed as a Director of the Corporation for the remainder of unexpired terms of office to expire May 31, 2025.

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SECTION 2. Any and all actions taken by each Director of the Corporation following the expiration of his or her prior term and any and all actions taken by the Board of Directors of the Corporation during that same time, are ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
