





# FY 2024 Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Hiring Program Grant -Background



- Offered by the United States Department of Justice
- Provides for a competitive grant program
  - \$156.6 million available for FY 2024 Program
  - 5-year award performance period to allow for recruitment and hiring
  - 36 months of officer salary is chargeable to grant
  - Requires a local cash match
- Allows law enforcement agencies to hire and/or rehire additional police officers
- Supports increase in community policing capacity and crime prevention efforts

# COPS Grant Award History

- Since 2015, SAPD has been awarded funding to add 104 officers
  - 2015: 4 Officers for Mental Health
  - 2017: 25 Officers for Gun Violence
  - 2020: 25 Officers for Domestic Violence
  - 2023: 50 Officers for Violent Crime



# FY 2024 COPS Hiring Grant Application

- 50 additional police officers
- Add officers to Patrol to address UTSA Violent Crime Reduction Plan, the Good Neighbor Program, and enable the Department to make progress towards a 40/60 split of on call and proactive policing
- Grant amount of up to \$6.25 Million
  - Provides a maximum of \$125K per officer over a 3-year period for salary and benefits
- Requires a 25% Cash Match
- Application deadline: June 12
- Award period: October 2024 to September 2029



# Grant Fiscal Impact

- General Fund amount includes the 25% required match plus other expenses not covered by the grant such as vehicles, supplies, overtime and pre-funded retiree healthcare
- Grant requires the City to fund 100% of the police officers for 12 months after the 3-year grant period

- Staff recommends City Council approves the submission of grant application, and acceptance if awarded, for the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Hiring Grant
