
Purpose

The SAFD Mobile Integrated Healthcare program would like to renew the donation for the Haven for Hope Acute Care Station program. South Texas Crisis Collaborative (STCC) and leadership from Haven for Hope, SAFD MIH, and the CentroMed Sarah E. Davidson Clinic have developed a collaborative model to address patient's medical needs in the evening and overnight hours when healthcare resources are limited on the H4H campus: the **Haven for Hope Acute Care Station**

2016 thru Current




- Significant decrease in transport volume during MIH ACS working hours

- Percentage of patients transported decreased from >70% to <25%


Results Overview

Plan of Action

- Perform acute care and treatment at H4H Acute Care Station: 8:00pm – 12:00am
- Respond to ALL calls originating from H4H: 7:00pm – 7:00am
- Patient Care Reports filled out on ALL 911 calls and patient contacts
- Determine the need for treatment, transport or referral (schedule appointment with CentroMed)
- Tele-Medicine contact with SAFD Medical Director as needed




Recommendations
