Background



- Immunization and Vaccines for Children Program:
 - Metro Health receives funding from the CDC's Immunization and Vaccines for Children grant for immunization programming and vaccine management in Bexar County.
 - The program has two components: The Vaccines for Children (VFC) Program and the 317 Immunization Program (Section 317 Program).
 - Grant allows for continued work in providing education, outreach, technical support, immunizations, disease surveillance, adult/adolescent health activities, immunization registry activities and vaccine distribution services.

Background



- City Council authorized approval of Metro Health’s Immunization and Vaccines for Children Program for FY 2025 through Ordinance 2024-06-13-0447.
- Metro Health anticipated receiving funds from the CDC in the amount of \$3,093,451.00 but was awarded additional funds in an amount up to \$636,185.00 for a total amount up to \$3,729,636.00.
- These funds will support the continuation of the Immunization and Vaccines for Children Program, as well as an existing personnel complement of 30 full-time positions.

Fiscal Impact



- Authorize the acceptance of funds from the CDC:
 - Additional amount: up to \$636,185.00
 - Total amount: up to \$3,729,636.00
 - Term: July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025
 - There is no cash match requirement and no fiscal impact to the City's General Fund

Recommendation
