

**ZONING CASE Z-2024-10700135 CD (Council District 1):** September 3, 2024

A request for a change in zoning from "C-3 AHOD" General Commercial Airport Hazard Overlay District to "C-3 CD AHOD" General Commercial Airport Hazard Overlay District with a Conditional Use for Oversized Vehicle Storage on Lot 64, Block 2, NCB 1774, located at 1010 Warner Avenue. Hina Martin, the applicant, stated the land next to her property has limited use due to it being in a flood zone. Ms. Martin was seeking to accommodate oversize vehicle storage.
