SUBJECT:

Council Consideration Request by Councilmember Manny Pelaez (District 8) and Councilmember Adriana Rocha Garcia (District 4) on creation of the Innocence Reclaimed Project.

SUMMARY:

Council Consideration Request by Councilmember Manny Pelaez (District 8) and Councilmember Adriana Rocha Garcia (District 4) on creation of the Innocence Reclaimed Project.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On August 10, 2023, Councilmember Pelaez and Councilmember Rocha Garcia submitted a Council Consideration Request (CCR) for the creation of the Innocence Reclaimed Project - a funded and staffed program. The CCR states that the project should provide: 1) legal assistance to residents eligible to receive criminal history expungements as set out by the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure; 2) a continuous city-wide public education campaign which informs expungement eligible residents of their rights and resources; and 3) wrap-around services

to qualified individuals who avail themselves of the right to expungements (eg. housing assistance, employment assistance, etc.).

ISSUE:

The CCR states that the design of the proposed Innocence Reclaimed Program should be informed by input from stakeholders and experts who have worked with formerly incarcerated individuals such as Texas Rio Grande Legal Aid, St. Mary's University School of Law's Center for Legal and Social Justice, MALDEF, NAACP, the Consul General of Mexico, the Bexar County District Attorney, the San Antonio Bar Association, the San Antonio Young Lawyer's Association, San Antonio Municipal Court judges, The Bexar County Public Defender's Office, All of Us or None, South Alamo Regional Alliance for the Homeless, and other relevant non-profit organizations dedicated to assisting San Antonians with access to housing and employment opportunities.

At the March 20, 2024 Governance Committee Meeting, staff recommended this item be brought back to the committee in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This item is for briefing purposes only with fiscal impact to be determined later based on the scope of the program proposed.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends this CCR be referred to the Community Health Committee. The Community Health Committee will work with City Staff to develop the design and scope of the program and to determine the appropriate department to coordinate the effort going forward.
