ORDINANCE

**AUTHORIZING THE SAN ANTONIO OFFICE OF EMERGENCY
MANAGEMENT TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND APPROPRIATE UPON
AWARD UP TO \$1,000,000.00 FROM THE 2023 STATE HOMELAND
SECURITY PROGRAM GRANT.**

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WHEREAS, there are grant funds of as much as \$855,522.92 available from the 2023 state Homeland Security Program Grant (HSPG); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the 2023 HSPG is to enhance the ability of governments to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of international terrorism and “all hazards” disasters impacting the Alamo Area Council of Government Regions which encompasses the City, Bexar County and the surrounding 13 counties and suburban cities within these counties; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of money for the current applications is \$855,522.92, but if another jurisdiction fails to spend their award within the allotted time the Office of the Governor may award additional funds up to a total of \$1,000,000.00 to the City of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, this grant does not require and accept a cash match or an in-kind contribution; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and designee, and the Emergency Management Coordinator (EMC) and designee, are hereby authorized to submit a grant application and accept grant funds upon award in an amount up to \$1,000,000.00 for the 2023 HSPG to assist the City in preventing, responding to, and recovering from acts of international terrorism and disasters, to fund implementation of the following projects:

- Grant ID 2963809 – Law enforcement Regional Response Capabilities (\$398,321.26)
- Grant ID 2999608 – Domestic Violence Extremism - Homeland Strategic Planning (\$216,211.08)
- Grant ID 4100804 –Information and Intelligence Sharing and Cooperation (\$240,990.58)

SECTION 2. The City Manager and designee, and the EMC and designee, are hereby authorized to accept said grant, if awarded under substantially the same terms and conditions as applied for, and are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said application and acceptance, and any additional money awarded under this grant.

SECTION 3. Upon acceptance of this award, a new fund and internal order number will be created, upon which the sum not to exceed \$1,000,000.00 will be appropriated from the Office of

the Governor, Homeland Security Grants Division. A final and formal budget, which will include Internal Order numbers and General Ledger numbers, will be submitted by the department upon award.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. In the event of loss or misuse of the SHPG funds, the City assures that the funds will be returned in full.

SECTION 6. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
