ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING A SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$550,000.00 FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE FY 2025 COMPREHENSIVE SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE PERIOD FROM OCTOBER 1, 2024 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2025.

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WHEREAS, September 5, 2024, the City Council approved the acceptance from the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDot) for a Comprehensive Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) Grant for the period of October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025, in the amount of \$1,200,000.00; and

WHEREAS, TxDOT notified the SAPD of a supplemental grant award in the amount of \$550,000.00;

WHEREAS, the grant will be used to enhance traffic safety related to driving while intoxicated, speeding, occupant protection, distracted driving and intersection related violations; and

WHEREAS, this is the twenty-fourth year TxDOT has offered this grant to the San Antonio Police Department (SAPD); and

WHEREAS, this supplemental grant does not require any additional cash-match, but requires an in-kind contribution of approximately \$120,620.00, which will consist of operational costs from the vehicles used while conducting grant activities, **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the San Antonio Chief of Police or designee, is hereby authorized to accept supplemental grant funds in an amount up to \$550,000.00 from TxDOT for the STEP grant for the period of October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025.

SECTION 2. The City Manager and designee, and the San Antonio Chief of Police and designee, are hereby authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said application and acceptance.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation

Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
