# Summary

---

- Authorizes execution of an amendment to an agreement with Urban-15 adding \$39,240 for dance and cultural art services at Robinette Community and Senior Center
- The revised contract, for a total value of \$164,240, will expire on March 31, 2029



# Background

Human Services provides comprehensive services to older adults (60+) at city operated senior centers

Services include:

- Exercise classes & programs
- Dance classes
- Technology
- Health screenings
- Wellness education
- Food security
- Financial Navigation and benefits counseling





# Solicitation Process

---

- A Request for Proposal (RFP) for dance and cultural arts services was released on November 15, 2023
- Five-member Evaluation Committee selected Urban-15 Group out of two submissions
- Urban-15 Group is the current provider of dance and cultural arts at senior centers



# Issue



- Authorizes amendment to increase total contract value to \$164,240 with Urban-15 Group to provide dance and musical programs for older adults for the remaining term starting April 1, 2025 and ending March 31, 2029
- Through this agreement, Urban-15 Group will provide dance and cultural arts services to members at five senior centers within Districts 2, 3, 4 and 5, including the newly opened Barbara “Robbie” Robinette Community and Senior Center
- The amendment adds an additional \$39,240 to the original amount of \$125,000 to extend services to the new center
