Mayor Pro Tempore Whyte called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m.

Angela Huang recommended a San Antonio River cleanup day.

Jemm Morris recommended improvements in City procurement and finance processes.

Darin Johnson stated that Animal Care Officers needed more training to handle dogs.

Antonio Diaz opposed Project Marvel, which was the downtown Sports & Entertainment District.

Joshua Hinson called for more services for homeless, accountability of the police, and decriminalization of sidewalk chalk art.

Pete Ibarra cited a failure of the system to help his father who died and had been living in poor conditions despite welfare checks.

Martha Huerta stated that she was evicted unfairly and was unable to get a job.

Jason Paul questioned the City policy of no food or drinks in City Council Chambers noting that members of the City Council were drinking water on the dias.

Carl Markle stated that there was an attorney and judge organized crime ring in San Antonio.
