ORDINANCE

**APPOINTING RENE PRESAS, CHARLIE WARD, FATIMA GUERRERO,
JOSEPH BROWN, SIDNEY THOMPSON, RUBEN GUERRERO,
DOMINICA McLENDON AND TAMMY WINCOTT TO THE CITIZEN
ADVISORY ACTION BOARD FOR TWO YEAR TERMS OF OFFICE.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 3 of Article 29 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of San Antonio, Texas and the San Antonio Police Officers' Association, passed and approved by San Antonio City Council on May 12, 2022, the San Antonio City Council must select persons from a list of applicants provided by the City Manager to serve as members of the Citizen Advisory Action Board (CAAB); and

WHEREAS, there are currently eight vacancies on the CAAB, composed of fourteen persons, which hears investigations on complaints made against police officers for misconduct, use of force and violation of the San Antonio Police Department General Manual; and

WHEREAS, the term of appointments on the CAAB is for a two-year period, beginning the effective date of this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, applicants were interviewed by a four-person panel, which consisted of Deputy City Manager Maria Villagomez, Chief of Police William McManus, First Assistant City Attorney Elizabeth Provencio, and Captain Alyssa Campos, and the City Manager and Chief of Police recommend each of the persons listed in Section 1 of this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the list of recommended appointees is representative of the diversity of the community, in that the list includes four females and four males, and is comprised of four Hispanics, two Caucasians, and two African Americans; and

WHEREAS, input and recommendation of the San Antonio Police Officers' Association shall be obtained as to the recommended appointees; and

WHEREAS, those on the list must meet the minimum qualifications established by Subsection 143.006(c) of the Texas Local Government Code for service on the San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager submitted such a list and all of those on that list meet the minimum qualifications; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The following persons are selected and appointed to serve as members on the CAAB:

1. Rene Presas
2. Charlie Ward
3. Fatima Guerrero
4. Joseph Brown
5. Sidney Thompson
6. Ruben Guerrero
7. Dominica McLendon
8. Tammy Wincott

SECTION 2. The service of the members on the CAAB shall begin when this ordinance takes effect, and shall be for a term of two years, to expire on December 12, 2025.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
