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Background



- U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) is a division of US Department of the Interior.
- USGS monitors, analyzes, researches and provides earth, water, biological and mapping data.
- Interlocal Agreements are required to grant USGS right of entry permission to complete installation of gauging stations at no cost to the City.

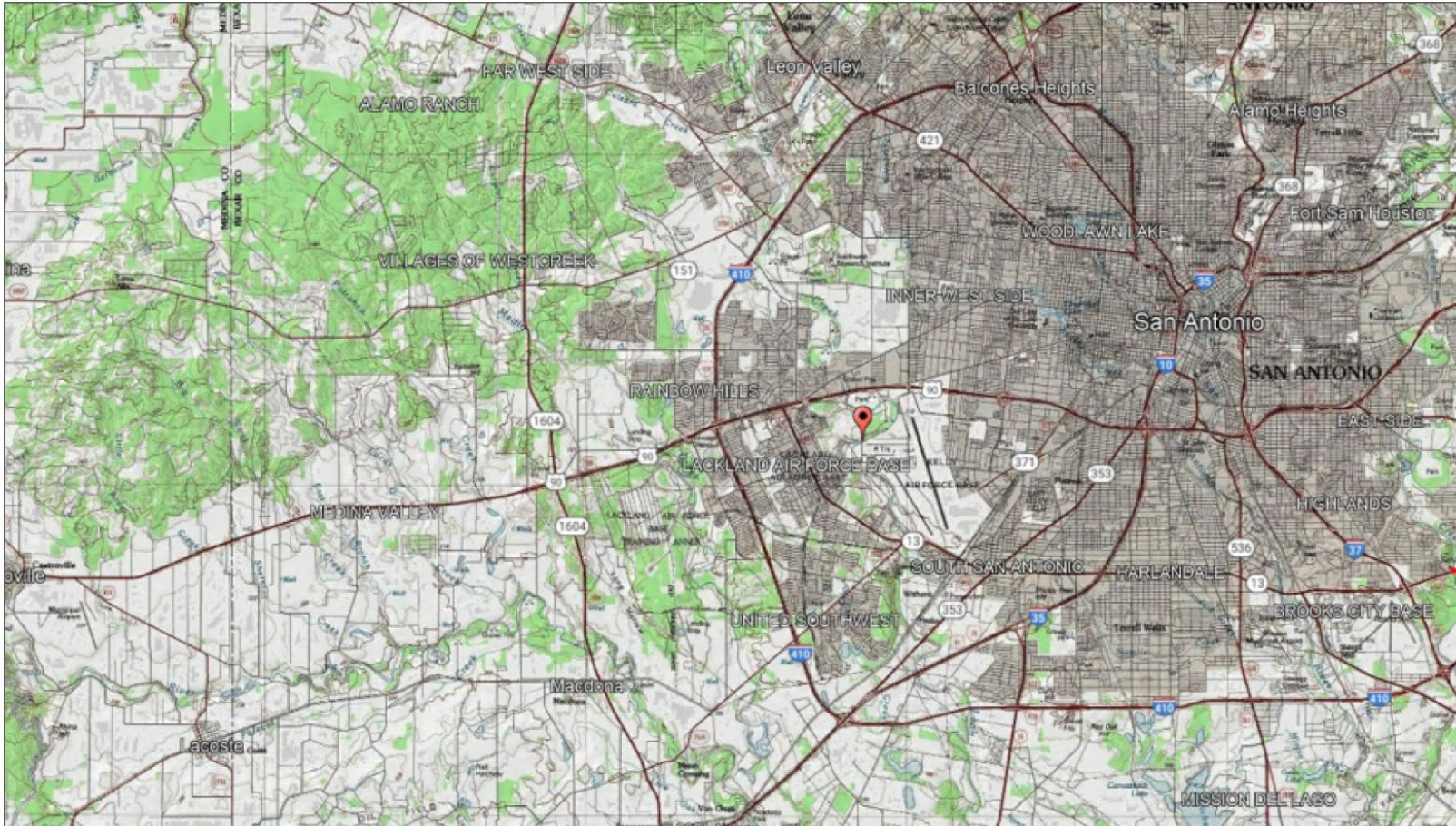


Interlocal Agreement Purpose

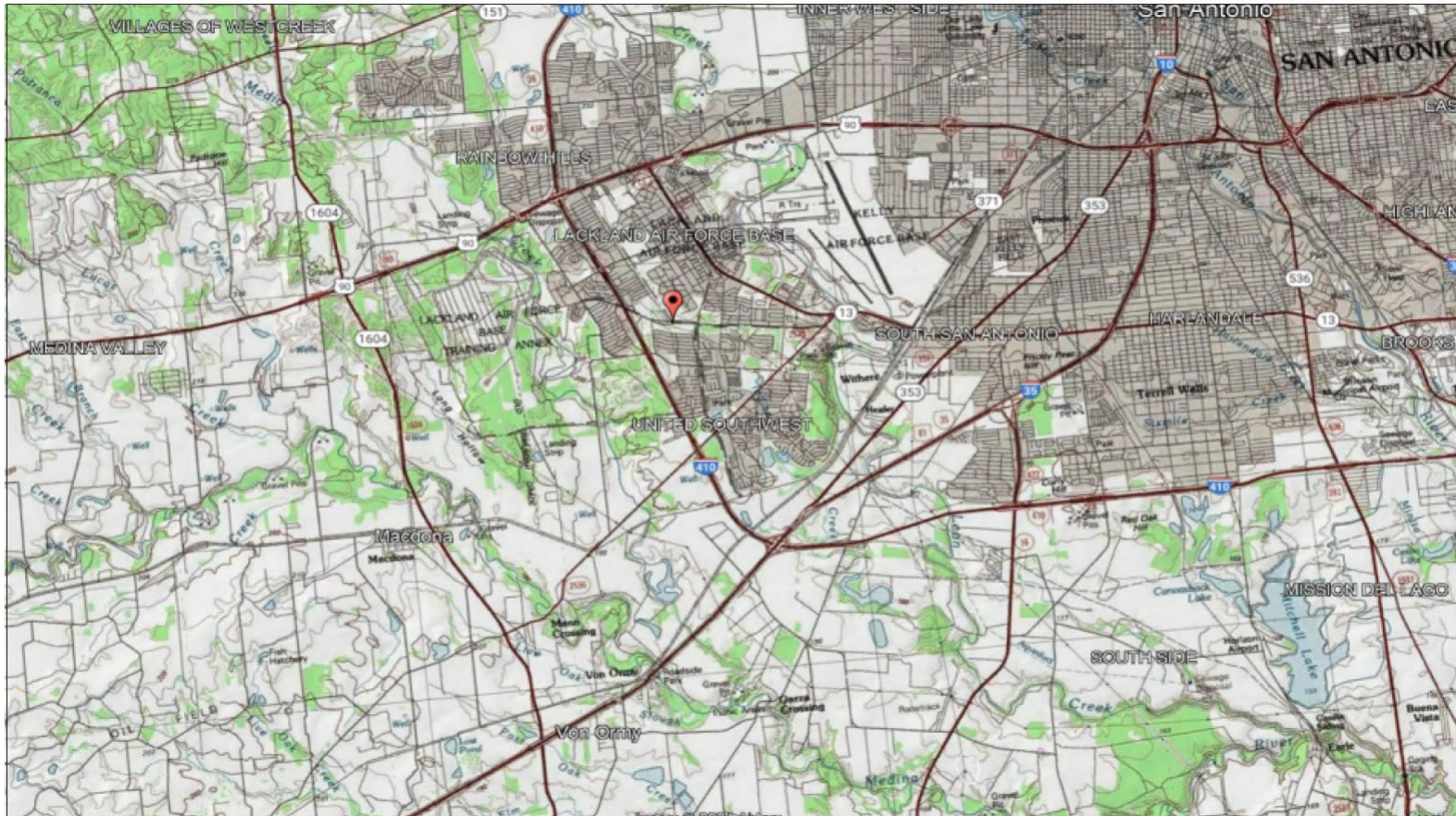
Grants right-of-entry permission to U.S. Department of the Interior U.S. Geological Survey for the installation and maintenance of gauging stations for streamflow measuring and water-quality sampling at two locations:

- Leon Creek at Morey Road
- Indian Creek at Medina Base Road
