
Background

- Rittiman is a four-lane minor arterial that serves approximately 23,00 vehicles per day.
- As part of the FY 2024 Budget, \$1.2 Million was authorized for design and environmental clearances.
- In June 2023, the City was awarded \$4.8 Million from Federal Railroad Administration for design and environmental review.
- Project will design solutions to eliminate issues with vehicular traffic due to high rail volume and operations.
