ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRIBUTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND THE SAN ANTONIO MEDICAL FOUNDATION TO ACCEPT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$77,876.02 TO FUND HALF THE COST OF A TRAFFIC IMPACT ANALYSIS FOR HAMILTON WOLFE AND FLOYD CURL DRIVE; A 2022 BOND FUNDED PROJECT LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 8. FUNDS WILL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE FLOYD CURL DRIVE (HUEBNER ROAD TO CHARLES KATZ) PROJECT

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; and

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2022, voters approved the 2022 Bond Program, which included \$12,000,000 for Floyd Curl Drive (Huebner Road to Charles Katz) project, which will construct roadway improvements to include curbs, driveway approaches and drainage; and

WHEREAS, as Hamilton Wolfe and Floyd Curl is an intersection within the project limits, the San Antonio Medical Foundation requested a traffic impact analysis of the intersection in preparation of a future 1.4 million square foot Veterans Administration Hospital that will be built at this intersection, in order to determine what improvements should be considered in a future bond project to improve the roadways in the South Texas Medical Center area to account for the increased traffic that the new hospital as well as other developments are expected to generate; and

WHEREAS, as part of the overall Bond project, the City of San Antonio fully funded the traffic impact analysis, and the San Antonio Medical Foundation has agreed to reimburse the City half the cost of the study, \$77,876.02, towards the cost of a traffic impact analysis on Hamilton Wolfe from Babcock Rd. to Fredericksburg Rd. and on Floyd Curl Drive from Hamilton Wolfe Road to Huebner Road; and

WHEREAS, the engineering firm Pape-Dawson Engineers was utilized under an existing task order based contract with the City to conduct this study and the results have been shared with the Medical Center Foundation; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance approves the execution of a Contribution Agreement between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Medical Foundation to accept funds in the amount of \$77,876.02 to fund half the cost of a traffic impact analysis for Hamilton Wolfe and Floyd Curl Drive, a 2022 Bond funded project located in Council District 8, and authorizes the appropriation of funds from the San Antonio Medical Foundation to the Floyd Curl Drive (Huebner Road to Charles Katz) project; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Public Works Department or designee, is authorized to execute of a Contribution Agreement between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Medical Foundation to accept funds in the amount of \$77,876.02 to fund half the cost of a traffic impact analysis for Hamilton Wolfe and Floyd Curl Drive, a 2022 Bond funded project located in Council District 8, and authorizes the appropriation of funds from the San Antonio Medical Foundation to the Floyd Curl Drive (Huebner Road to Charles Katz) project.

SECTION 2. Funds received for this ordinance in the amount of \$77,876.02 from the San Antonio Medical Foundation are authorized to be appropriated in Fund 45099000, Project 23-03902, WBS Element 23-03925-90-10-01 and GL Account 4502280.

SECTION 3. Funds in the amount of \$77,876.02 is authorized to be appropriated in Fund 45099000, WBS Element 23-03902-01-02-08 and GL Account 5201245.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Fund Numbers, Project Definitions, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, Fund Centers, Cost Centers, Functional Areas, Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
