

RFCA #23-194928

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Emergency Management Coordinator (EMC) or designee, is hereby authorized to apply for and accept in an amount up to \$1,000,000.00 from the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grants Division for the 2024 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP). These are Management and Administration (M&A) grant funds that were unspent by the Office of the Governor. The awards do not require a cash match or an in-kind contribution from the City.

SECTION 3. Upon acceptance of this award, a new fund and internal order number will be created, upon which the sum not to exceed \$1,000,000.00 will be appropriated from the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grants Division. A final and formal budget, which will include Internal Order numbers and General Ledger numbers, will be submitted by the department upon award.

SECTION 4. The personnel complement of one (1) position, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**, is approved.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
