**AN ORDINANCE**

**AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF LINE-OF-DUTY  
INJURY LEAVE FOR SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT  
FIRE ENGINEER CLINTON COOPER.**

**WHEREAS**, section 143.073 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that a firefighter injured in the line of duty is entitled to line-of-duty injury leave with full pay for a period commensurate with the injury and not to exceed one year; and

**WHEREAS**, section 143.073 also provides that a municipality's governing body may extend the line-of-duty injury leave beyond one year; and

**WHEREAS**, San Antonio Fire Department Fire Engineer Clinton Cooper was injured in the line of duty on January 15, 2022, and, as a result, required leave in excess of one year to address said injury; and

**WHEREAS**, Fire Engineer Cooper is requesting an extension of line-of-duty injury leave beyond one year for the period January 16, 2023, to October 9, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, approving the requested extension will restore 1,608 hours of accrued leave to Fire Engineer Cooper; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** An extension beyond one year of San Antonio Fire Department Fire Engineer Cooper's line-of-duty injury leave for the period January 16, 2023 to October 9, 2023, is hereby approved.

**SECTION 2.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
