ORDINANCE

APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH DONALSON-HINER AUTOMOTIVE GROUP, INC., DBA SILSBEE TOYOTA, FOR 48 HYBRID AND ELECTRIC VEHICLES FOR VARIOUS CITY DEPARTMENTS FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$1,747,091.00. FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,409,744.00 IS FROM THE EQUIPMENT RENEWAL & REPLACEMENT FUND, OF WHICH \$590,274.00 IS FROM THE FY 2024 ADOPTED BUDGET AND \$819,500.00 IS INCLUDED IN THE FY 2025 PROPOSED BUDGET, \$136,818.00 IS FROM THE TREE CANOPY PRESERVATION AND MITIGATION FUND FY 2024 ADOPTED BUDGET, \$158,166.00 IS FROM THE GENERAL FUND FY 2024 ADOPTED BUDGET, AND \$42,333.00 IS FROM THE AIRPORT OPERATING & MAINTENANCE FY 2024 ADOPTED BUDGET. FY 2025 FUNDING IS CONTINGENT UPON CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL OF THE BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio with hybrid and electric vehicles for use for administrative purposes by the Health, Center City Development and Operations, Development Services, Aviation, Convention and Sports Facilities, Parks and Recreation, Public Works, Information Technology Services, and San Antonio Police Departments; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Cavender Ford Motor Company, Ltd., dba Cavender Grande Ford, for item 3 failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements for 15 compact plug-in hybrid electric SUVs; and

WHEREAS, Donalson-Hiner Automotive Group, Inc., dba Silsbee Toyota, submitted the lowest responsive bid for items 1-8 and 11 for a total cost of \$1,747,091.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bid submitted by Donalson-Hiner Automotive Group, Inc., dba Silsbee Toyota, for items 1-8 and 11 for a total cost of \$1,747,091.00, is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I.**

SECTION 2. It has been found and declared that the bid submitted by Cavender Ford Motor Company, Ltd., dba Cavender Grande Ford, for item 3, failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements for the requested 15 compact plug-in hybrid electric SUVs.

SECTION 3. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$590,274.00 is available in Fund 72001000, Cost Center 3503200001 and General Ledger 5709080 as part of the Fiscal Year 2024 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 4. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$136,818.00 is available in Fund 29619000, Cost Center 2616010001 and General Ledger 5701085 as part of the Fiscal Year 2024 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 5. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$73,500.00 is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 3616010004 and General Ledger 5701065 as part of the Fiscal Year 2024 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 6. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$42,333.00 is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 3804040103 and General Ledger 5701080 as part of the Fiscal Year 2024 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 7. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$42,333.00 is available in Fund 10001000, Cost Center 3804040103 and General Ledger 5701080 as part of the Fiscal Year 2024 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 8. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$42,333.00 is available in Fund 51001000, Cost Center 3305030002 and General Ledger 5709080 as part of the Fiscal Year 2024 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 9. Additional funding is contingent upon City Council approval of the Fiscal Year 2025 and subsequent budgets that fall within the term of the contract.

SECTION 10. Payment in the amount of \$1,747,091.00 is authorized to with Donalson-Hiner Automotive Group, Inc., dba Silsbee Toyota, and should be encumbered with a purchase order(s).

SECTION 11. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 12. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
